The Symposium, co-sponsored by the Lacy Foundation and the Atlantic Coast Conference Intercollegiate Academic Consortium (ACC/AC), will take place on **November 12 – 14, 2010**, in Blacksburg, Virginia.

The symposium presents research by undergraduate and graduate students from regional, national, and international colleges and universities. Students will present both individual and collaborative work from diverse fields, including psychology, history, media studies, and theater, and in a range of presentation formats, such as papers, oral or poster presentations, and multi-media projects. **Panel and presentation categories include:** Peace Practice through Service Learning; Harnessing New Media for the Prevention of Violence; Violence Prevention and Conflict Resolution; Violence Prevention and the Arts; and Economics, Politics, and War.
