Mission:

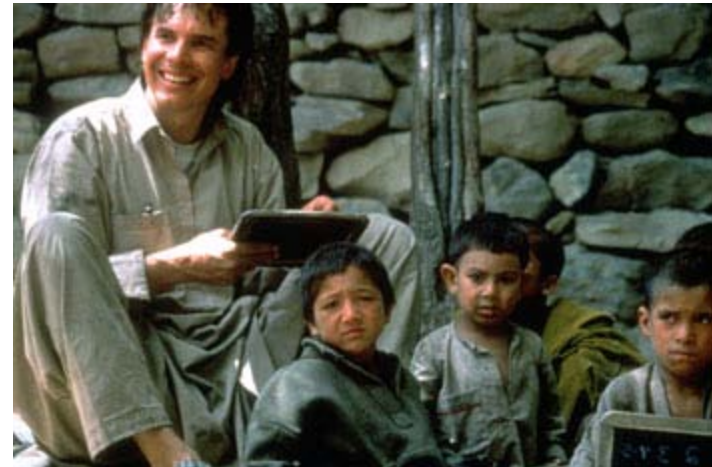
